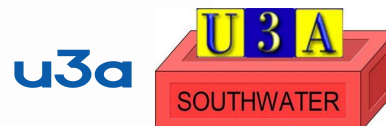

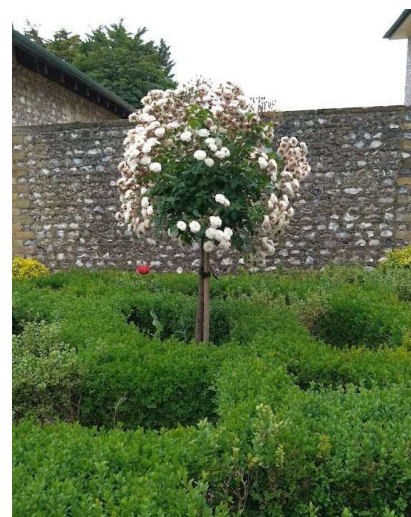

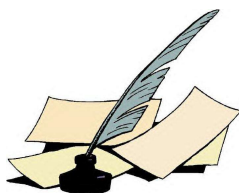
The Garden Group at Selhurst Place
