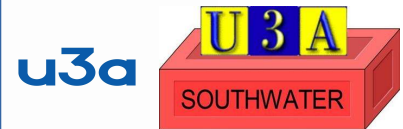

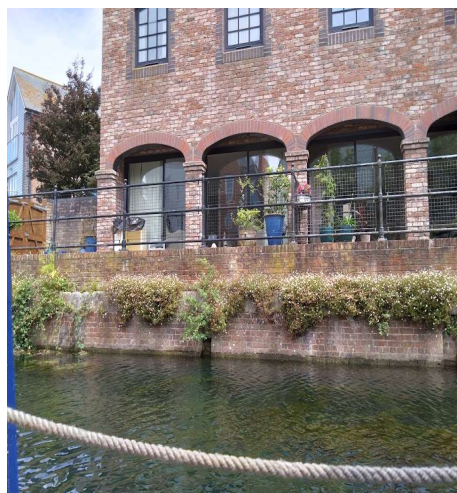

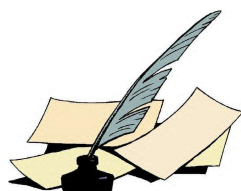
The Garden Group at 47 Denmans Lane
