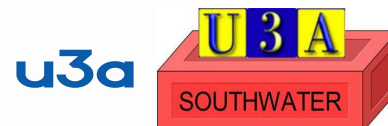

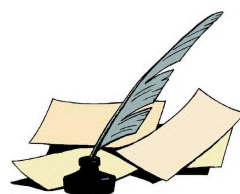
The first Garden Group outing of the year was to Shamley Wood Estate and did not disappoint! Annes Ruby and Harwood share some of their lovely photos with us.
